Psychotherapist/Trainer-Iraq

The Psychotherapist/Trainer works as part of an interdisciplinary team to address the trauma rehabilitation needs of survivors of torture, human rights violations, and/or conflict-related violence. The Psychotherapist/Trainer will oversee psychological interventions, provide supervision, coaching, and training to staff psychologists and mental health counselors, and provide education and support to help other organizations better meet the needs of survivors.

Qualified candidates should have a Master's degree or equivalent in Clinical Psychology or Counseling; at least five years' experience providing psychotherapy to children, adults, families, and groups; experience or competencies in managing and supervising staff, including supervision and professional development leadership to staff of varying experience; experience working in the region.

About CVT: The Center for Victims of Torture works toward a future in which torture ceases to exist, and its victims have hope for a new life. We are an international nonprofit dedicated to healing survivors of torture. We offer rehabilitation services to those who have been tortured, train partners around the world who can prevent and treat torture, and advocate for human rights and an end to torture. We are headquartered in Minnesota (with two locations in the Twin Cities and one in St. Cloud), and we have US offices in Georgia and DC, as well as offices in Africa, Mexico and the Middle East. In the US, our work focuses on working with refugees, immigrants and asylum seekers who are survivors of torture or war trauma.
